

PREREQUISITE CHANGES for THE NURSING PROGRAM
Effective for the 2012 nursing program

LEVEL I: Chemistry course change

- NEW chemistry course: **CHE 10400 Chemistry for Health Sciences** will be offered for the first time in the Fall 2012 semester. This course will be the new prerequisite for Anatomy & Physiology I.
 - If you have already completed CHE 10000, you will not be required to complete this new chemistry course prior to enrolling in Anatomy & Physiology I.
 - If you have already completed (or had transferred in) BIO 23500 and 23600 Anatomy & Physiology I & II, you will not be required to enroll in this course.
 - High school chemistry with a grade of B or better within five years will be accepted.
- ANATOMY & PHYSIOLOGY: BIO 10700 Essentials of Anatomy & Physiology will no longer meet the prerequisite requirements for the Level I program beginning with the Fall 2012 program.

LEVEL II: PREREQUISITE COURSES **ELIMINATED FROM THE ASSOCIATE DEGREE NURSING PROGRAM (DADN1) effective for the Fall 2012 program:**

- POL 10100 Introduction to American Government
- SPE 10500/11400 Fundamentals of Speech or Interpersonal/Public Communications
