- Prerequisite courses may be repeated one time only to obtain the required grade.
- Students should seek advising from the Health Careers Department only.
- All felony convictions and certain misdemeanor convictions will prohibit admission to the nursing program.
- A “Request for Admission to Surgical Technology” application form must be submitted between December 1 and March 1 each year.
- Immunization records and Health Care Provider Recommendation are required for final admission (refer to the “Required Abilities” form).
- Students are ranked for acceptance into the program based on:
  1. Anticipated date of completion of prerequisite course work.
  2. Date of college application declaring surgical technology as program of study.
- Program course work must be completed within two years.
- Prerequisite courses must be completed with the required grades for admission to the surgical technology program.
