

How to Apply

Students wishing to live in the Service House or participate in MSS must meet the following criteria:

- GPA of 3.25 or higher (Service House only)
- A past history of service experiences
- A dedication to bettering your community through service

Applicants will also need a letter of recommendation from someone who can speak to their ability to work cooperatively with others.

The House

The Service House is located on Kirtland's main campus just a short walk from your classes! It has a full kitchen, three bedrooms, two bathrooms and is fully furnished, with satellite TV and wireless internet. There will be four students selected to live in the house and they will each share a bedroom.

Additionally, there will be a Michigan Campus Compact, AmeriCorps*VISTA member living in the house who will provide supervision and serve as the Coordinator and work with students to plan service projects for other Kirtland students.

What is Michigan Service Scholars?

Michigan Service Scholars (MSS) is a program that allows students like you to be AmeriCorps members while you are in school! Students complete 300 hours of service over one year and are rewarded with an Education Award of \$1,132 once they complete their hours.
