To be eligible for Michigan Reconnect expansion, students must:

- Be at least 21 years of age and not more than 24 years of age.
- Apply and enroll in a community or tribal college no later than fall semester 2024.
- Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).
- Have lived in Michigan for at least a year.
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent or certificate of completion.

All applications must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. EST on Nov. 15, 2024.

CONTINUING ELIGIBILITY

To maintain eligibility, students must meet all of the following conditions for the Reconnect Program:

- Continue to be a Michigan resident.
- Maintain enrollment in a Pell-eligible program at a community or tribal college leading to an associate degree or industryrecognized certificate or credential.
- Earn at least 12 credits each academic year, once the individual begins coursework.
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress as determined by the institution or a cumulative 2.0 GPA since becoming a Michigan Reconnect scholarship recipient.
- File the FAFSA for each academic year.
