****Utilizing the document "Dual Enrollment Cost Reporting Guidance" the cost is \$489 per credit hour based off the Activity Classification Structure report (ACS) total operating expenditures divided by total credit hours reported in ACS for 2015-2016 reported by Kirtland Community College. Tuition assessed to students in 2015/2016 was \$105 in-district or \$146 out-of-district. There was also an option for the high school to purchase an entire general education class at a rate of \$8,000 per college class or a skilled trades class at a rate of \$13,000 per college class.**
