**Utilizating the document "Section 209 Reporting Guidance" the cost is \$536 per credit hour based off the MCCDI report total operating expenditures divided by total credit hours reported for 2020-2021 reported by Kirtland Community College. Tuition assessed to students in 2020/2021 was \$121 in-district or \$182 out-of-district. There was also an option for the high school to purchase an entire general education class or a skilled trades class, rates are based on class purchased.
