- Completion of all coursework as shown above. Required coursework, if not completed, must be taken at Northwood University, or completed as transfer credit.
- A minimum of 123 credit hours are needed to obtain a B.B.A. from Northwood University.
- A minimum of 31 credit hours must be completed with Northwood University.
- All transfer coursework must be college-level; remedial coursework is not considered college-level.
- All Adult Degree Program students are required to take FDN 2500 for zero or 1 credit.
- Students may incorporate additional minors or majors, but this will involve additional coursework. Please see a Northwood University Academic Advisor.
