Michigan Army and Air National Guard Grant

Guidelines and Application Procedures

Eligibility Criteria:

- Be admitted to a certificate or degree-granting program at Kirtland Community College;
- Be a member in good standing with Michigan Army or Air National Guard;
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress at Kirtland Community College.

How to apply:

- Apply for admission to a certificate or degree-granting program at Kirtland;
- Complete the attached *Kirtland Community College/Michigan Army and Air National Guard Grant Application Form* to apply for the grant;
- A representative from your unit (personnel must in the chain of command) must verify on the application that you are an eligible member of the Michigan Army or Air National Guard and return the form to Kirtland.
- Upon receipt of the form Kirtland will award a grant to be applied to course fees, based upon student enrollment as follows:

1 – 5.99 credits	\$125
6 – 8.99 credits	\$200
9 – 11.99 credits	\$275
12 or more	\$350

Other Assistance Programs:

- Complete a *Free Application for Federal Student Aid* (FAFSA) www.fafsa.gov to be considered for Federal grants/loans. Kirtland's Title IV school code is 007171.
- Federal Tuition Assistance – www.GoArmyEd.com or call Joshua Fenner, Education Specialist with the MIARNG at 517-481-9841. Federal Tuition Assistance *may waive up to* \$4500 of tuition per academic year.
