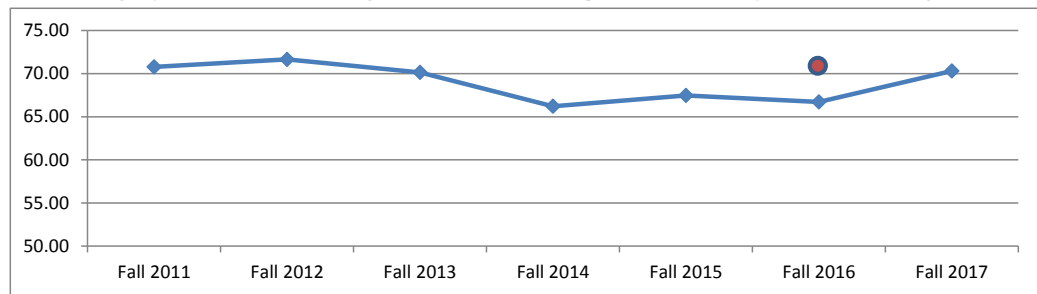

Percent of credit students that were enrolled in the fall term and are still enrolled in the next full academic term less students who graduated. Dual enrolled students are not included.

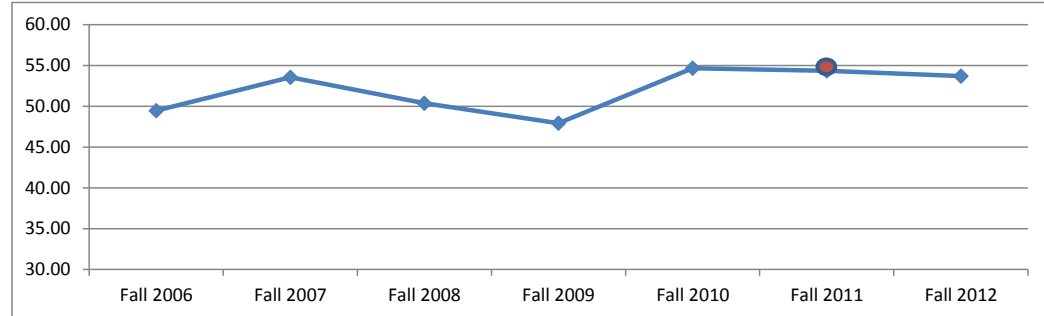

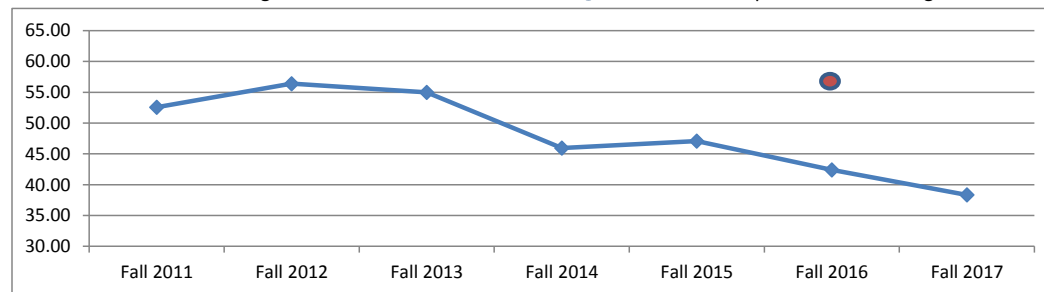
